2.7.1. Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance (Institution may design the questionnaire) (Results and details be provided as weblink)

Students Satisfaction Report is prepared on the basis of questionnaire prepared by the college. All students are divided into different tutorial groups and one teacher is assigned to every group to listen and redress the problems of the students. One period in a week is assigned for this purpose. Students are also free to contact their teachers during their free periods for study related problems.

The excellence of education is measured on the basis of how satisfied students are, with the teaching process. Two parameters are important to study the quality of teaching process, depth of the coverage of the syllabus and standard of test assignment. The institution prepares a questionnaire (Student's Feedback form for Teacher Evaluation) at the end of each academic year and get it filled by the students to know the students' view on academic, co-curricular and other student related activities and facilities. Designed Questionnaire is attached at the end of the report.

On the basis of response from the students given in the questionnaire, a report is prepared. The feedback of the students can be summed-up in following points:

1. Nearly 70 percent of students observed that coverage of syllabus in classroom is excellent and another 25% as very good.
2. About 56% students perceived the organisation of class tests and assignments is excellent and nearly 30% as very good.
3. Nearly 72% of students reported that teachers have excellent command over the subject and interestingly no student reported it below average.
4. Teachers take pains in preparing their lectures. They are excited about what they teach, for they invite questions from students on subject matter. (63% students remark excellent to this provision and nearly 28% as very good.
5. With regard to use of teaching aids (blackboard, Smart boards and overhead projector, about 75% mark it excellent and nearly 20% as very good.

6. About 73% students' remarks as excellent with regards to completion of syllabus in time and another 18% as very good.
7. Scheduled organisation of assignments, class tests, seminars and class presentations by students is a regular features of Students pursuing Post Graduate degree. Above 90% of Post graduate students feel excellent in this regard.
8. Nearly 66% students give excellent remarks to provisions of quality education provided in the institution. Less than two percent remark these provisions as an average and no student reported these provisions at below average level.
9. On an average, about 62% student feel as excellent about the teachers regarding inviting opinion and questions from students on subject matter and another 20% mark it very good.
10. Nearly 90% students of post graduate departments feel that help from teachers in realizing career goal is excellent.

Considering all the parameters of quality education and teaching, we can conclude that the students' perception regarding different parameters are in line with legacy of the college.
