She addressed the students by saying that there are two types of patent applications: provisional and non-provisional. The non-provisional patent application is the one that most people need to use. Provisional patent applications were created to put the inventors on equal footing with foreign inventors. A provisional patent application does not give you a provisional patent. Instead, it stops the clock with regard to statutory bars, and you get a placeholder that allows you to lay claim to the initial filing date for purposes of showing your priority date for a patent. Intellectual property rights relate to a person’s creativity. It protects the right of patenting the technology and machine learning process. On this occasion a total number of 25 students were present along with Ms Amita and Ms Preet Kamal.
