#### **College Background**

This Historical and Glorious Institution of Punjab has begun in 1856 AD as a Sanskrit Vidyalaya by Maharaja Randhir Singh. Later it was promoted as Degree College in 1945 AD. In 1978, the name of this institution was changed to Sultan–E–Qaum, Nawab Jassa Singh Ahluwalia.

In addition, in 1968, Masters in English, 1976 Masters in Economics, 1986 Bachelor of Commerce, 1991 Bachelor of Science (Economics, Computer Science) and under Self-financed Scheme PGDCA classes were started. Streams like M.Com & B.C.A included in 2004 & 2020 respectively. Various National and International Sportsmen, Writers, Politicians, Social Workers, Administrators and reputed Teachers have been produced by this rich traditional institution. I wish a bright future for this eminent college of mine.

#### **Staff Achievements**

#### **College Library**

The College Library is running smoothly under the leadership of Dr. Jasmeet Sethi. The Library contains 35,928 books, 12 newspapers and 35 magazines. 15 magazines are resourced from different means and gifted to the college. Library Reading Hall is spacious enough to accommodate 200 students one time peacefully.

SVEEP is under supervision of Professor Happy Kumar .Under the SVEEP programme students are made aware of applying online and offline Votes, corrections in Voter Cards and Polling. Poster Making, Seminars, Essay-Writing and Slogan-Writing activities were conducted for students to aware them about Voting process. Two students Janhvi B.A. II and Sanjeet Singh B.A. II are appointed as student ambassadors under Vote Awareness Programme.

Every year the College celebrates Voter's Day and Constitution Day. The College Staff help the administration by performing different duties assigned to them as Officers, Assistant Presiding Officers, and Polling Officers etc.

#### **Buddy Group**

College Buddy Group is under the guidance of Professor Happy Kumar. Poster Making, Seminars, Essay Writing and Slogan Writing Competitions are conducted under the Buddy programme to make the students aware of severe effects of Drugs. A special monthly, weekly and fortnightly lecture is conducted for the Buddy group students and its purpose is to spread awareness about adverse effects of drugs. The College currently consists of approximately 30 senior Buddies and 238 Buddy Groups.
