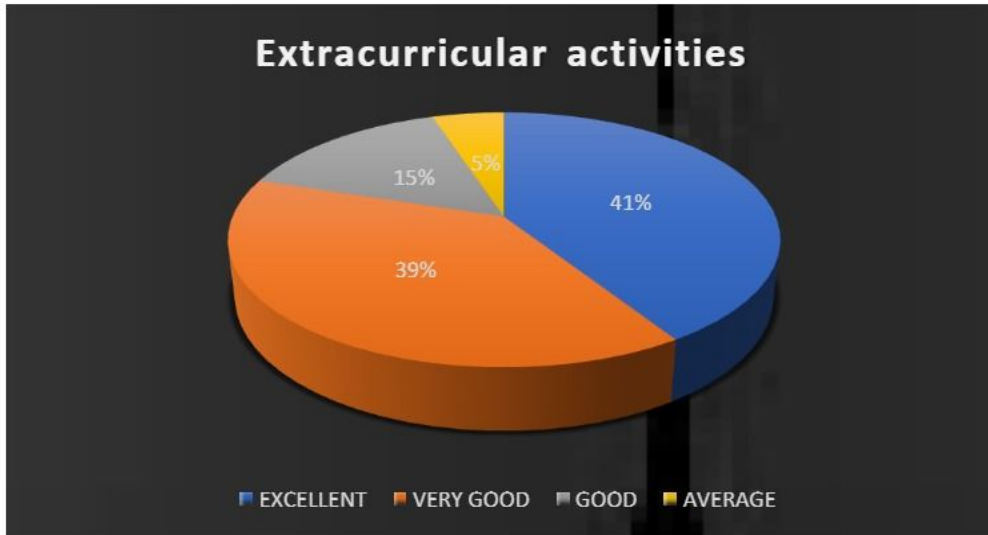


TABLE 18 :- Inculcate soft skills, life skills

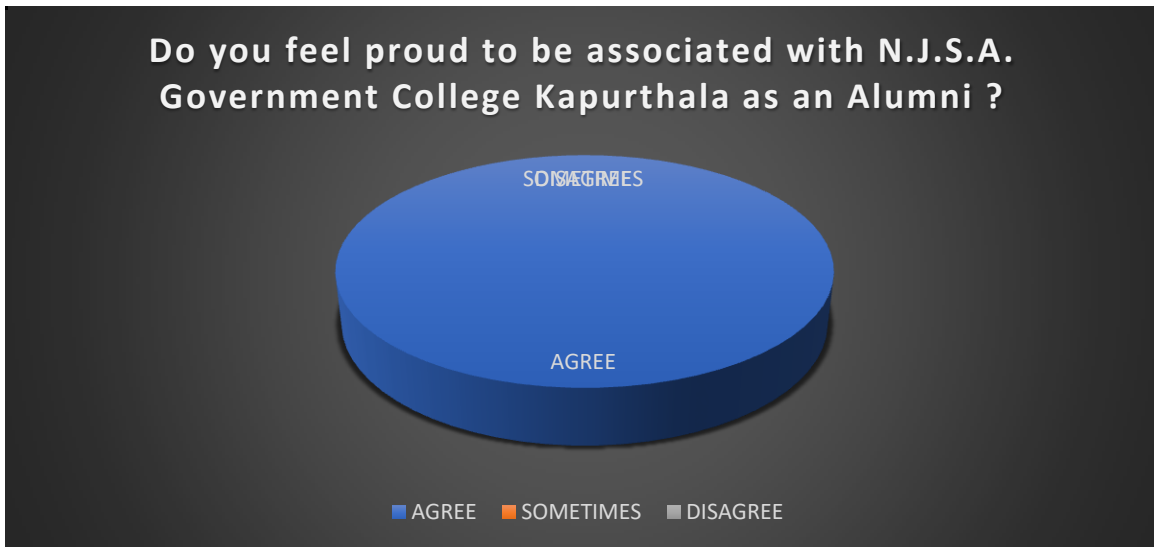


TABLE 2 :- College is having adequate infrastructure with respect to academics and extra curricular activities

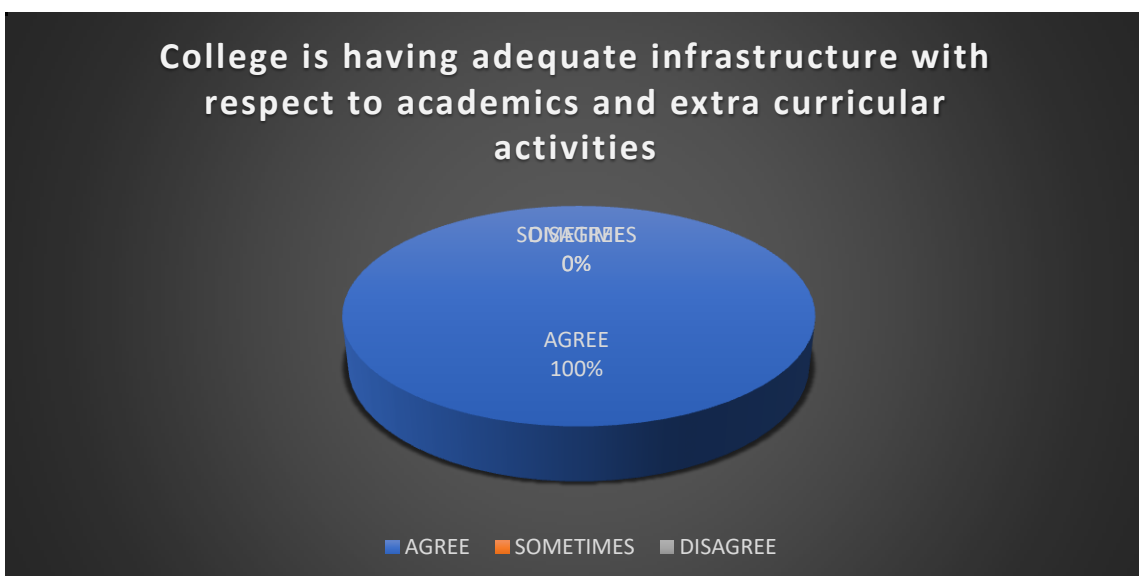


TABLE 3 :- You would recommend the College to your near and dear ones for academics and overall excellence

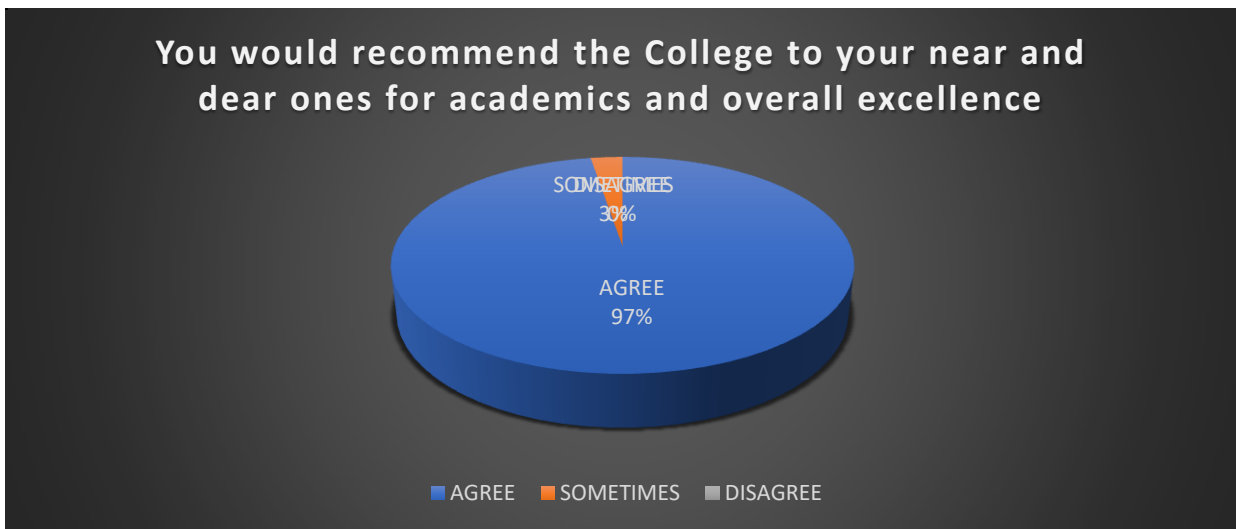


TABLE 4: - Teachers were effective in solving your problem

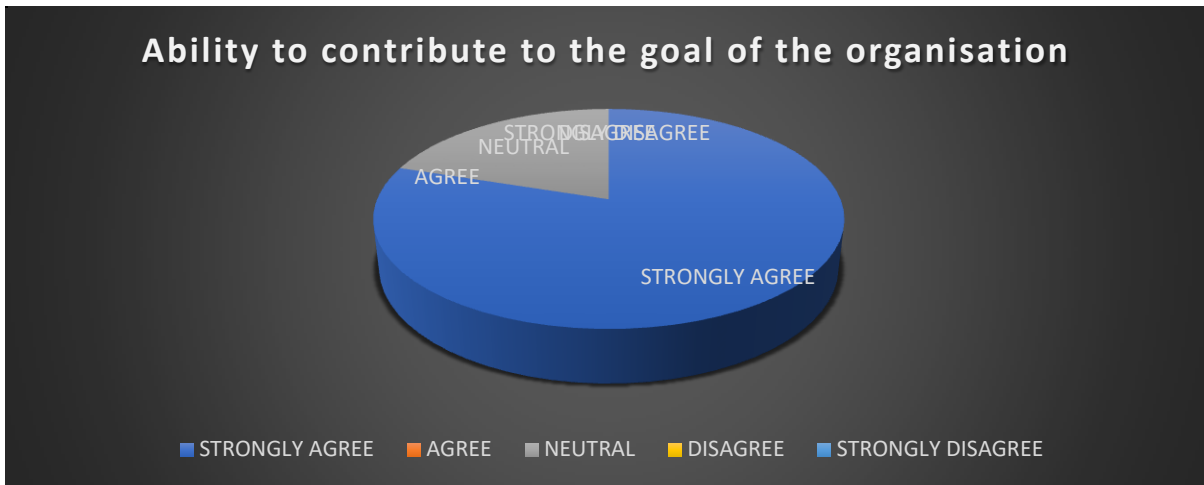


TABLE 2 :- Curriculum enhances analytical skills

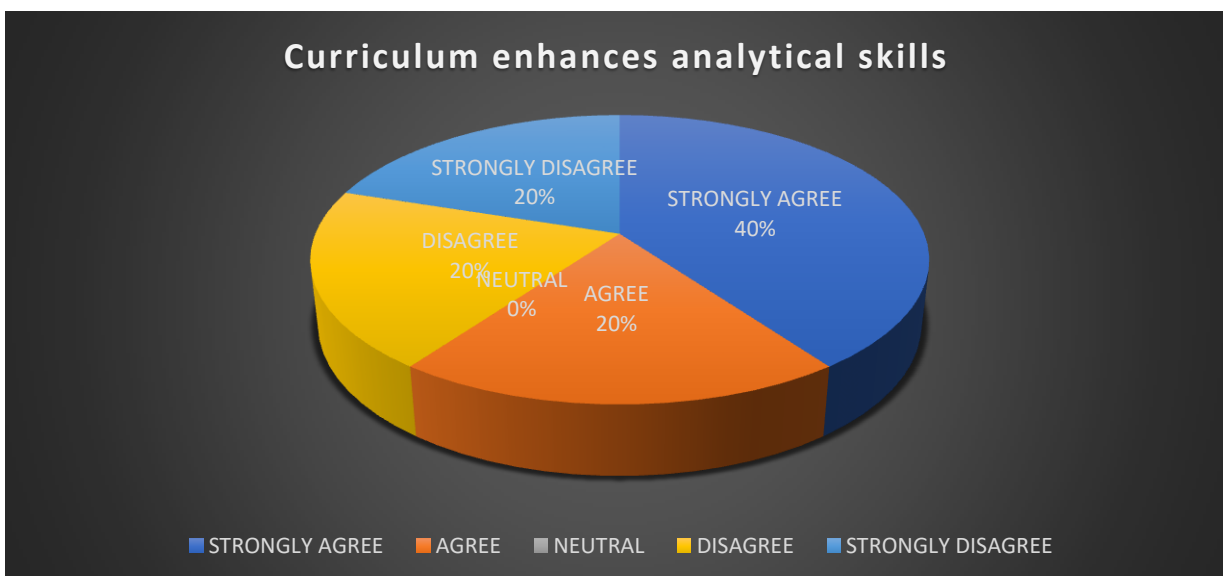

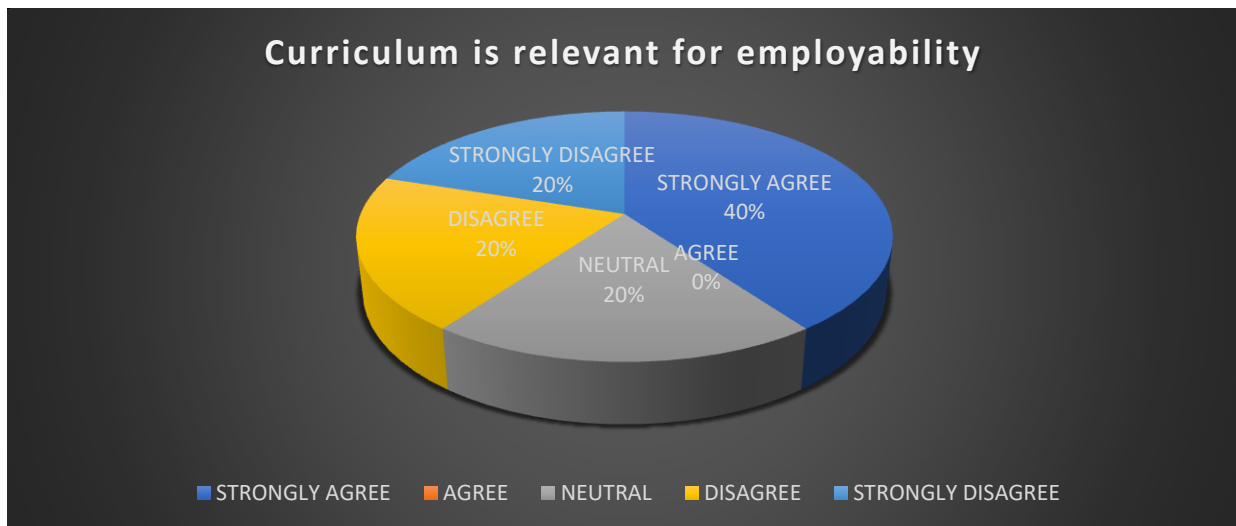

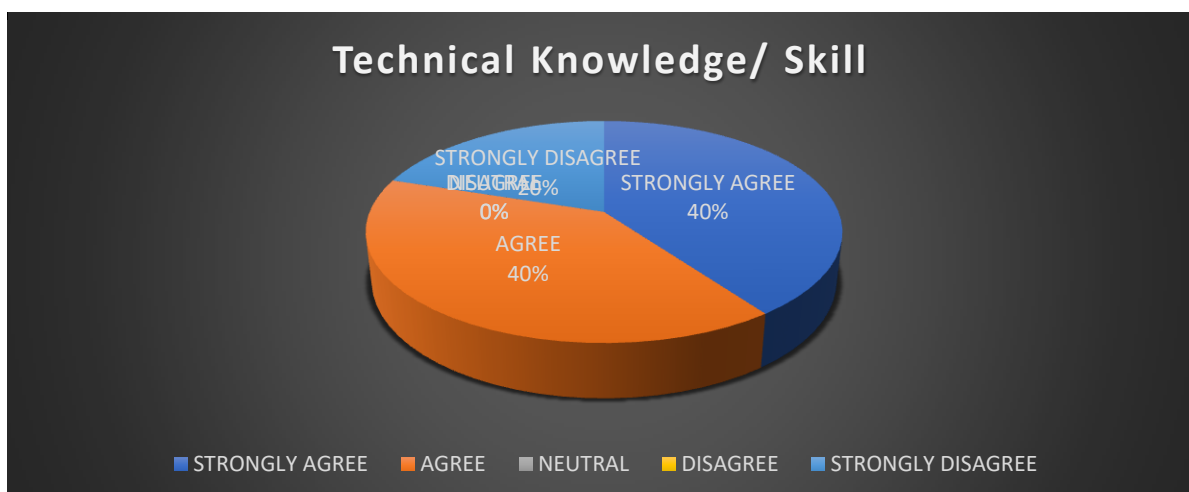


TABLE 5 :- Creative in response to workplace challenges

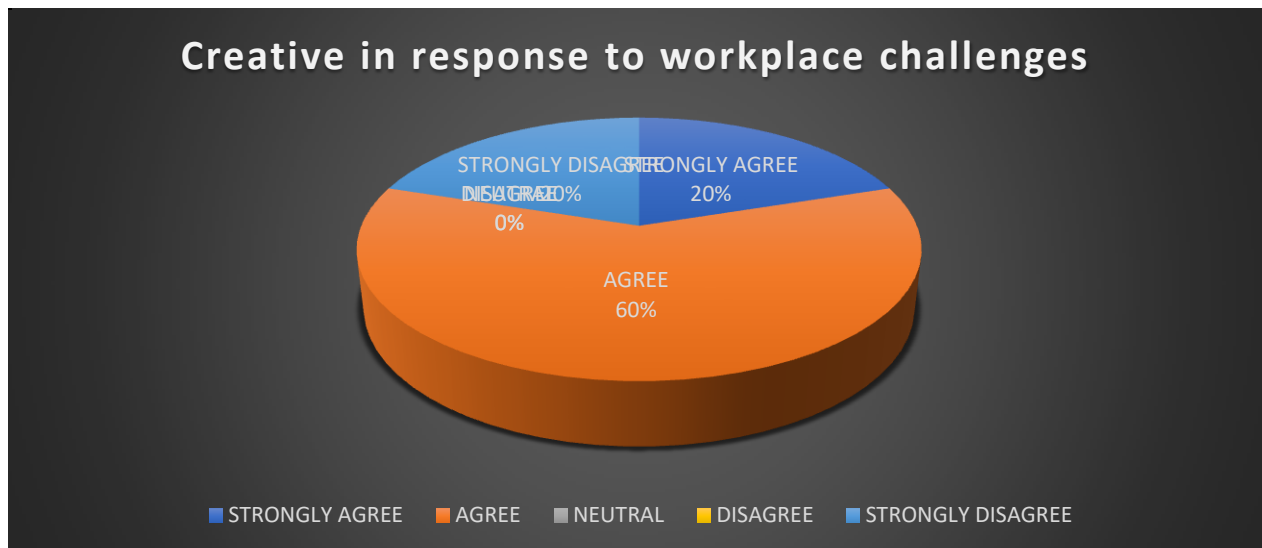


TABLE 6 :- Ability to take up extra responsibility

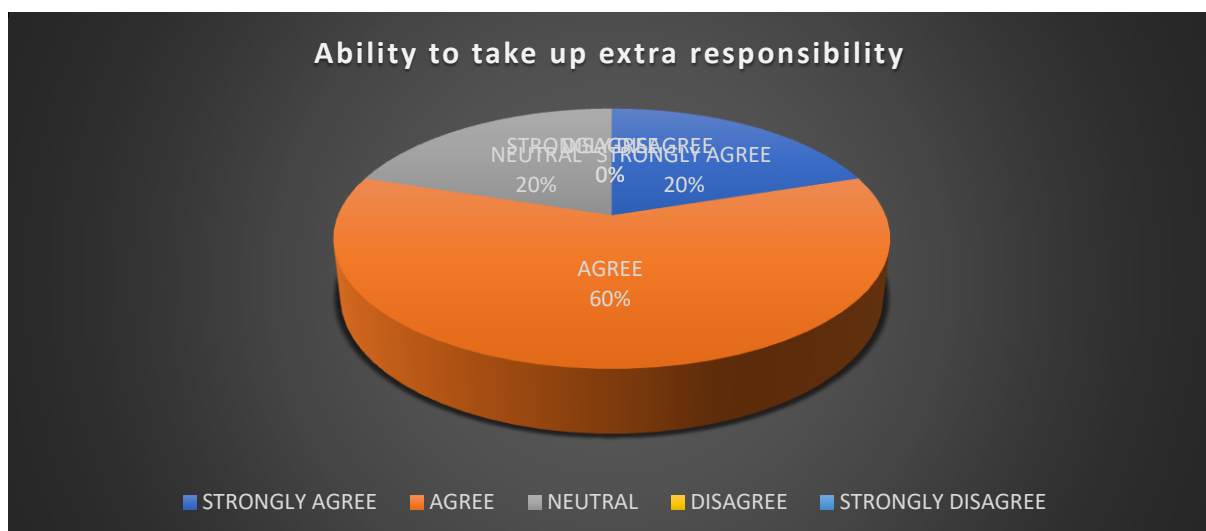
