Proceeding of the meeting :-

The points discussed and approved in the meeting are as follows:-

1. Principal Sir, Dr. Tirath Ram Baser welcomed the members of the IQAC for their presence in the meeting. He chalked out the 'Plan of Action' for the academic year 2023-24.
2. Principal Sir told that the teachers have been asked to prepare the 'Teaching Plan' for

the odd semester and teaching should be as per the plan prepared by each teachers. and to maximum use of ICT facilities of the College will be stressed.

3. Principal Sir ~~said~~ felt satisfaction that the NAAC reaccreditation process of the College is going on satisfactorily. IOA has already been approved by the NAAC and process of preparing Self Study Report for the NAAC is going on.
4. Principal Sir told that admission process in the College is complete as per the guidelines of GNDU, Amritsar and Department of Higher Education Govt. of Punjab. College is able to increase the total strength of the College from 1199 in 2022-23 to 1226 in 2023-24. for this, he Congratulated the entire staff of the College.
5. Principal Sir said that Parents 'Teachers Association' (PTA) will be Constituted for the session and students will be given representation in various Committees of the College.
6. Principal Sir said that students will be encouraged to enrol for NCC, NSS and other extra Co-Curricular activities for their overall personality development.
7. Career & Counselling Cell of the College will be further strengthened to guide the students for their better future. for this purpose, it will ~~will~~ work with District Bureau of Employment and Enterprises (DBEE), Kapurthala.
8. for the personal guidance and mentorship of the students, Tutorial groups will be set up and tutorial periods will be arranged during the session.
9. Efforts will be done to develop the learner-Centric

environment conducive to quality education and faculty development.

10. For faculty development and up-to-date knowledge of the subject, teachers will be encouraged to attend National level seminars/workshops.

Seminars and ~~workshops~~ workshops will be arranged in the College also.

11. Principal Sir said that for monitoring the academic performance of the students, Class Tests, Classroom presentation, assignments and Mid Semester examination (MST) will be conducted during the session.

12. For implementing the Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme properly, Principal Sir told that 'Scholarship Help desk' and Scholarship facilitation Centre will be set up in the College. It will work for the filling of Scholarship Card for the eligible students and applying for scholarship.

13. Principal Sir told that College has received special grant under HE-24 Scheme of Punjab Govt. for repair and renovation of the College building. This work is to be done by PWD, Kapurthala. Liaison will be made with PWD, Kapurthala for speed up the work of repair and renovation.

This grant also covers the grant for construction of new parking for staff members.

14. Principal Sir told that construction of new Conference Hall is almost complete and the ~~tender~~ process of tender for furniture-fixture in that Hall is going on.

15. Teachers will be encouraged to present the research papers in various seminars/workshops and research activities will be strengthened in the College.

Similarly extension lectures will be arranged from eminent persons in the subject for the benefit of the students.

16. Principal Sir also talked about the provision of remedial classes for the slow learners especially for the socially and economically weaker section of the Society.
17. Principal Sir ~~also~~ said that library facilities will be further strengthened with new edition of books and Computers. Students will be encouraged to get the maximum benefit ~~from~~ the library facilities.

2. The chairperson appraised the members about the successful completion of NAAC Accreditation 2023 and congratulated all the members. Informing the

members regarding NAAC Peer ^{Team} Visit, the principal joyfully told that N.J.S.A. Government College, Kapurthala has successfully completed its third cycle of NAAC Accreditation on 13.12.2023.
